City of Chicago Projects

Regulations impacting construction machinery currently in use took effect in Chicago on June 1 of this year. The recently passed Chicago Clean Diesel Construction Ordinance requires the use of Ultra-Low Sulfur Diesel (ULSD) and meeting any state or local reduced idling

regulations in construction equipment used for contracts awarded by the City of Chicago that exceed \$2 million. This is the latest of several in-use rules already enacted in the greater Chicago area, including the Cook County Green Construction Ordinance and the

O'Hare Modernization Program.
